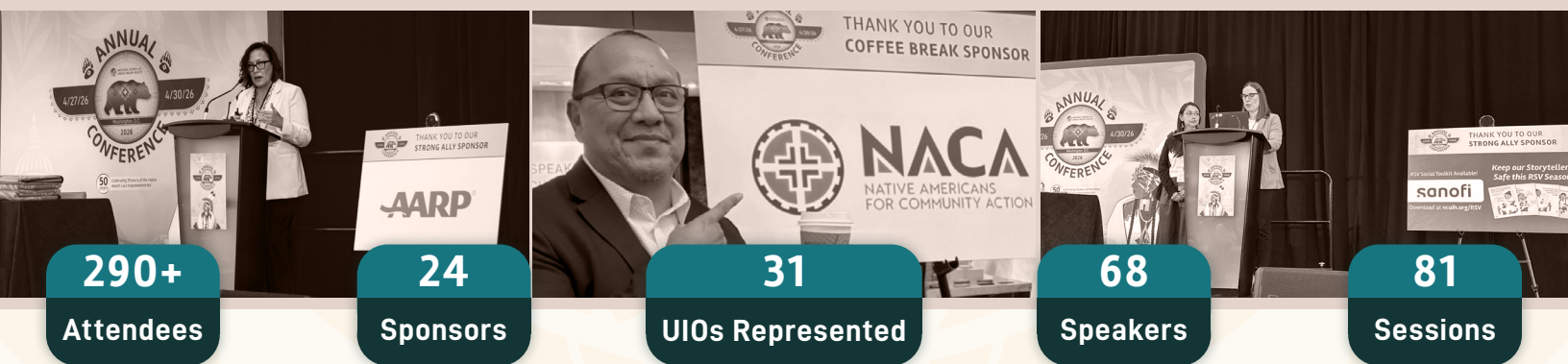

IMPACT & RESULTS



Each year, NCUIH's national conference serves as a catalyst for collaboration and measurable impact across Urban Indian Organizations and partner networks. The 2026 Annual Conference brought together nearly 300 attendees and 24 sponsors, generating more than 82,117 sponsor impressions.

92.3% of attendees said NCUIH met conference expectations.

PREMIER PARTNERSHIPS



Native Health Visionary | \$100,000 *(One available)*

The conference's premier partnership. Forty-five minutes of live speaking on the main agenda are yours — a workshop or panel you shape — along with the largest presence we offer across the program, the app, and the room. Ten registrations included. This level demonstrates your commitment to urban Indian health nationally and support for NCUIH's ongoing work.



UIO Champion | \$50,000

Twenty-five minutes of live speaking on the agenda, six registrations, and full recognition across every channel we have — opening remarks, newsletter, a dedicated social post, the mobile app, and the annual report.



Partner Leader | \$40,000

Ten minutes of live speaking, five registrations, and recognition in the opening remarks that frame the conference. Full visibility across the program, signage, and mobile app.

SUPPORTING LEVELS GROUP 1



Health Ally | \$25,000

Your message reaches the room without requiring your team to travel for a speaking slot. A five-minute video plays during the conference, your full-page ad runs in the program, and four registrations are included. Strong visibility with a lighter lift.



Community Builder | \$15,000

Three registrations and visible recognition throughout the conference — your logo on the welcome slides that open each day, on the thank-you banner, and a half-page ad in the program every attendee carries.



Health Warrior | \$10,000

Two registrations, a half-page ad, and logo recognition across the conference. A straightforward way to be present and be seen.



SIGNATURE OPPORTUNITIES

Welcome Bag Sponsor | \$20,000 *(Two available)*

Your logo travels with every attendee for the length of the conference, on the bag they carry to every session. The most visible single placement we offer. Includes a half page program ad.

Networking Sponsor — Leader Mixer | \$20,000 *(Three available)*

Host the leadership mixer. You are recognized as host, offer brief welcome remarks, and have a dedicated sign at the event — the setting where the conference's relationships get made.

Coffee Break Sponsor | \$10,000 *(Six available)*

Your logo on the signage where the room gathers for coffee and a snack between sessions, plus recognition on the thank-you banner and the mobile app.



SUPPORTING LEVELS GROUP 2

Culture Keepers | \$5,000

Support the cultural grounding that makes this conference what it is. Includes a registration, a half-page ad in the program, and logo recognition on the welcome slides and thank-you banner.

Friend of NCUIH | \$2,500

Stand with NCUIH's mission publicly. Your logo appears on the welcome slides and the sponsor thank-you banner, and your organization is named in the conference program.

Ally | \$1,000

An accessible way to show your support. Your organization is named in the conference program and on the sponsor page, and included in group sponsor recognition.
