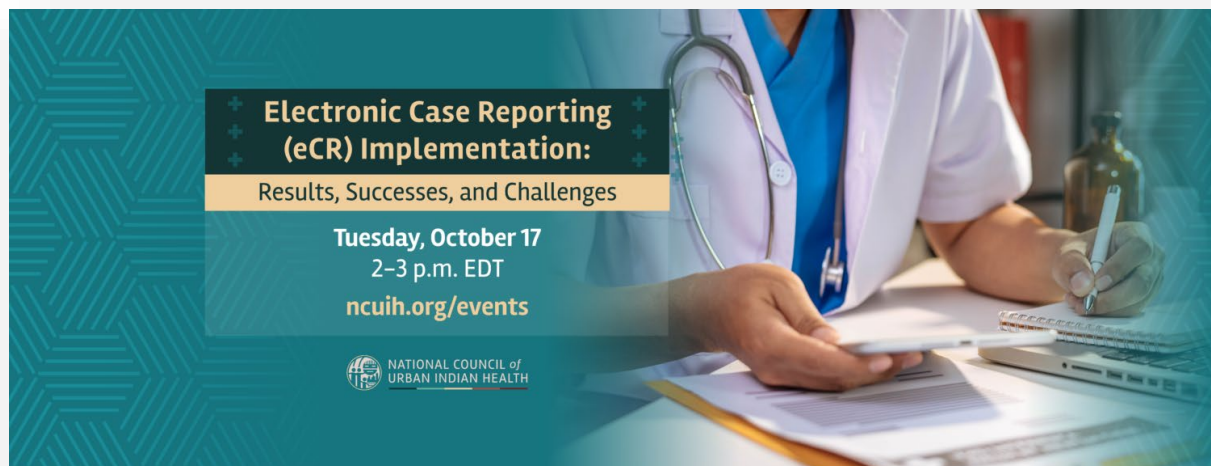

Electronic Case Reporting Overview

- Electronic Case Reporting (eCR) is the automated, real-time exchange of information from the healthcare facility to the public health agencies.
 - A provider enters the patient information into the electronic health record (EHR).
 - EHR data triggers a case report sent to the appropriate agency.
 - The provider receives a reportability response from the agency.
- There are currently 208 conditions that can be reported using eCR.
- Provider benefits include:
 - Time saving
 - Streamlines jurisdiction reporting challenges





- Fulfills all legal reporting requirements

eCR Implementation at the UIO Level

- Both Bakersfield American Indian Health Project (BAIHP) and Fresno American Indian Health Project (FAIHP) were part of the Year 1 eCR Project.
- Both projects have had delays with the process.
- Be persistent in communications with the EHR vendor.
